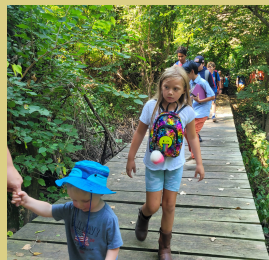
Pollinator Playground
